Course Introduction

This training is essential for operatives using any form of overhead gantry lifting equipment. This includes having a working knowledge of how the various machines operate and to identify the major components of the machine and explain their functions, including weight limits, and to carry out an effective pre-use check.

- Operating the crane in four directions
